


1. Ritchies Community Benefit Payment

Why sign up for a Ritchies card?

Receive member exclusive offers, digital coupons, saver cards, competitions, games and support AAAF!

Using the Community Benefit Program you can contribute to Support, Research and Awareness of Alopecia Areata without spending a cent more.





2. Container Scheme

Support AAAF and help the environment by recycling your empty beverage containers!

We're partnering with container deposit schemes across Australia, allowing you to contribute to AAAF while recycling.

Each State and Territory operate their scheme differently

NSW - Return and Earn Program

We are now a charity partner with Return and Earn. You can donate your 10-cent refunds to AAAF via nearby Return and Earn machines using their app.

VICTORIA - CDS Vic Program

Residents in Victoria can receive a 10-cent refund by returning eligible beverage containers through the CDS VIC initiative. CDS VIC comprises three zones managed by three different operators. We've partnered as a charity for all three zones. Depending on your location, download the CDS Vic East, CDS Vic West, or CDS Vic North app from your App Store. At the refund point, you can opt to donate your refund to AAAF by searching for "Alopecia" under "donations" in the app.



ACT, QUEENSLAND

& WESTERN AUSTRALIA

We are currently in the process of registering with Return-It and Containers for Change in ACT, QLD and WA. Please keep an eye out on socials for updates.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA

& NORTHERN TERRITORY

South Australia (SA) and the Northern Territory (NT) both operate container deposit schemes, but there's currently no app or registration option for charity partnership with one single organization in these areas. The most effective way to raise funds in SA and NT is by arranging events like collection drives and returning the containers to designated points. Businesses or sports clubs can also place bins for staff use, collecting funds from returned containers and then donating them to AAAF.
